CHRIS BAKER: Pleased with how it went. Yeah, looking forward to the weekend.

Q. Obviously very wet, they had to cancel play on Thursday. How much did the golf course dry out today?

CHRIS BAKER: It's drying quick. There's obviously some wet spots still that I think will be difficult for tomorrow going forward, but it's drying up unbelievably well and the course is in great shape, the bunkers are amazing. The staff did an incredible job really keeping up with what they had to deal with.

Q. It's been a challenging road, but you make your way to the PGA TOUR, you're a rookie this season. Anything in particular surprise you about how it's gone so far?
