

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

DANNY LEE (-10)

Q. So a 1 under today. How would you assess your round and your position in the tournament?

DANNY LEE: A little disappointing, 1 under today, but I'm still in it, I think. I think it's still a good week at the moment.

Q. What is it about this golf course that you like so much?

DANNY LEE: Probably tee to green, especially from the second shot areas. There's a lot of holes out there that I like a lot of the short irons. I think I can really take advantage when I cut well out there, I can make a lot of birdies out there. And obviously you have to hit the fairways first here. You hit a foul ball here, it's most likely in the hazard, so you've got to do both things right. I did that today, but putting, obviously didn't roll in where I wanted to, but I was making good strokes. It just got bumpy at the end, I guess.

Q. Dating back to CJ Cup, this is now nine of your last 10 rounds under par. So has there been anything different or something that you discovered about your game or just the way you're feeling?

DANNY LEE: Just the new swing starting to groove into my body. I don't have to have five or six swing thoughts every time I hit it, I really only have one swing thought at the moment and I feel comfortable with whichever shot I have to hit and that's a great feeling to have, I think.

Q. What's the biggest difference from the 62 to the 70 today?

DANNY LEE: Nothing much. Just missed a couple putts out there, made bogey on a couple par 5s. Just golf happened.
