Q. Got on a roll today, got yourself in the mix. Just some thoughts about that?

PAT PEREZ: Yeah, I felt good getting up this morning. I thought my eye line was bad on the greens and I just worked on it kind of last night and this morning started making some putts.

The greens got fast, though. I was surprised. In fact, I felt they were two, three feet faster, it was unbelievable. Especially coming in, 14 on, they were fast, which is fine, but you're not ready for it.

No, hopefully we get a mower on the grass tomorrow and, you know, we'll see what happens. It will be a long day and going to have to probably get another 12 out of it tomorrow.

Q. Got two past champions in the top-5 I think right now, so does that say something about the place?

PAT PEREZ: Maybe. But see, we never played in this wind, I've never played in it. Totally different shots. You play a course for eight years and you played the same wind all the time and get used to the same stuff. All of a sudden it comes out of the north and it changes a lot of holes. You know, you adapt to it obviously, but just different, it's just different.

I'm just glad we got the two rounds in. Hopefully we'll get in 36 tomorrow. I think you've got to get around this course a couple times to really kind of get a feel for the greens. And obviously the wind, you can't exactly tell where it's coming from because the trees out there don't really tell you anything. But I love this place, I love the weather. Everything here is just fantastic. I just love playing here.
