

BRENDON TODD (-20 through 14 holes)

Q. We'll start big picture, the day as a whole, how would you assess what you've been able to do so far?

BRENDON TODD: Today was a great day. You know, I went out there and hit it well, shot 9 under par with two bogeys. It doesn't taste so great that the last one came on the last hole, but it's all right. I'm tied for the lead with three to play and excited about the opportunity.

Q. Given the little swing of momentum that happened from 13 on, is the break almost welcome that it happened at this point?

BRENDON TODD: Yeah, definitely. I mean, there was probably no benefit for me to keep playing after making two fives in a row. I'll take it as a positive, try to get some rest and come out with some good shots in the morning.

Q. Game plan for tomorrow?

BRENDON TODD: Make that first putt, go from there.

Q. How much will last week and what you were able to do closing out there impact you in a positive way to close out this tournament?

BRENDON TODD: Well, I think it's helped a lot today. I felt really comfortable out there, was in control of my game and made a lot of birdies and pulled ahead. But it's totally different now. I had a four-shot lead there, maybe even a five-shot lead, so I wasn't feeling much pressure. Now that I'm tied for the lead, it's kind of a new ballgame and I'll have to go out there and hit good shots and try and fight them off.
