Q. You make the turn, you get it to 15 under par and a ways back, but what turned it around on the back nine for you?

ADAM LONG: Not much, honestly. I was kind of doing the same stuff I was doing. I had been tearing up that front side all week and was kind of striking out today, in that final round, but kept pushing away and kept hitting fairways and gave myself some looks and made some nice putts.

Q. How challenging is it for you to come out this morning, you've got three holes to play, at the time I think you were two back off the lead, how challenging is that for a player?

ADAM LONG: Yeah, it's a little weird. It's different, but I've kind of put myself in the mind of that we're teeing off of No. 1 and that helped. Instead of feeling I only this two holes left, I was giving myself like a bunch of holes, like 18 holes like normal. So I had a pretty normal routine, warm-up, and kind of didn't want to think in my head I only had five shots or something. I was thinking it's going to be a long, normal day.
