Q. Brendon, winning is a good habit to get into.

BRENDON TODD: No doubt. You know, golf (inaudible) inspires confidence and winning breeds winning, I think we've seen that over the years with Tiger.

Q. You lamented to me when we got off the air yesterday that nothing was going in. How long were you thinking about that putt last night, this morning? How many times did you practice it in your mind, and it was huge to get off to that start?

BRENDON TODD: Yeah. I mean, I was thinking about it all the way up until I came out to the golf course this morning. I just, I think I missed five putts between six and eight feet yesterday on the right edge and that's unlike me, that's a great zone for me. So there was just something there, and maybe I was peeking, maybe I did it again on 16, I don't know. Seemed like that putt just kind of went right on me. I made a couple putts that I had to make there on 15 and one at 18, so I'm just thrilled.

Q. The one on 16, how much did that impact what happened on 17 and 18, a chance to have a two-shot lead instead of a one-shot lead today? Did it impact anything in terms of how you had to play coming down the stretch?

BRENDON TODD: Well, it made me more nervous and it probably gave Vaughan a little more confidence, so I would say it had a big impact. I was literally walking around that green thinking I had a two-shot lead and feeling pretty comfortable and that wasn't the case.

Q. From a couple of years now ago to atop the FedExCup standings, can you even start to compartmentalize that?

BRENDON TODD: It is so surreal. It's just crazy, you know. Harris just said to me in the scoring area, it's just amazing how fast this game can turn. It turned fast in the wrong direction for me in 2015, it turned fast the other direction for me, so I'm enjoying it and I'm just going to keep grinding.

Q. Paradises have been good, too. We've got Bermuda, we've got the Yucatan. I know we've got RSM next week, but Maui in a couple of months. You go for the vacation triple here coming up?

BRENDON TODD: That would be insane. I played good at Maui the last time I was there, so hopefully I can be hot there and hit my wedges close.
