RHEIN GIBSON (-6)

Q. Rhein, you got 5 under through nine holes. You probably didn't have much experience on the new Plantation course, but did you feel like it was a course that you could be aggressive on?

RHEIN GIBSON: Very much so, yeah. The wind was down a little bit today and I kept putting myself in play and was able to attack the greens, so nice to turn at 5. Went to the front nine, would have been nice to get a couple more, but super stoked to finish at 6.

Q. When you look at how you could finish the season this fall with a solid week this week, does that kind of give you motivation to maybe finish strong?

RHEIN GIBSON: Definitely. You kind of look at the guys that came in my category that have already played really well, like Lanto winning in Houston and Harry finishing second in Bermuda, so we can definitely do it. So opportunities like this we have to take advantage of, so it would be nice to finish the year off nice here.

Q. You've had some solid starts so far. What did you learn your first time around on Tour that's helping you this time?

RHEIN GIBSON: I think just more of an experience thing. I mean, you know how to travel, you know where to travel, you know where the range is, you know where dining, just little things like that make you more comfortable. Knowing a lot of the guys now, you know, with being in either Korn Ferry or PGA TOUR, so familiar faces every week. I just feel a lot more comfortable out here my second year around.
