CAMERON TRINGALE (-6)

Q. Cameron, you birdied three of your last four holes for a 64. How much confidence does that give you going into the next round?

CAMERON TRINGALE: It gives me a lot of confidence. I had one little stumble on 14 and was able to rebound and get some momentum, so all positive things going into the first hole tomorrow.

Q. You played these courses quite a few times. When the weather is benign like this, do you know that you need to be a little bit more aggressive than otherwise?

CAMERON TRINGALE: I think you play what the course gives you and if you're in position, you've got to take advantage of good drives and short putts into these holes. Yeah, definitely, but if you're not in play in the right place, it can be really brutal out here.

Q. What was the best part of your game today?

CAMERON TRINGALE: I drove it well enough to give myself chances and I putted really well despite the one three-putt. I hooped a really long one on 12 and I cleaned up around the hole pretty well.
