

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

SCOTT BROWN (-10)

Q. Scott, another good round for you at 10 under par. You've got to be pretty happy with where you sit right now.

SCOTT BROWN: Yeah, extremely happy. Ball-striking's been really good the last couple weeks actually and just didn't make any putts last week and finally made some this week, so hopefully I can keep it rolling.

Q. Talk about the Plantation course compared to the other side. I mean, you've gone 5 under on both sides, so you must like them both.

SCOTT BROWN: I do. Plantation's much tougher now with the new greens, I think, than it was before. You just had to get it in the right quadrant. You could get some good looks if you got it in those quadrants with the greens the way they're tiered, but also, you know, on the other hand, if you've got them on the wrong side of them, you've got a tough two-putt. So I think it's a great golf course and they've made it a lot tougher.

Q. The scoring average at Seaside is actually higher today than Plantation. That's surprising some.

SCOTT BROWN: Yeah, I think it is, too. But, you know, they're both in really unbelievable condition. Seaside yesterday was incredible. Greens were as good as we play all year.

Q. Now you're on Seaside the rest of the weekend. What do you think about your chances?

SCOTT BROWN: Hopefully, if I can keep putting the way I am, I should at least give myself a chance come Sunday, so hopefully I can just keep doing that.

Q. And Aiken, South Carolina, isn't too far. You have some folks down here, right?

SCOTT BROWN: Yeah, three and a half hours. My family's here and a few people drive down to come to this one, so it will be fun.
