DENNY McCARTHY (-14)

Q. (In progress) feeling to be able to donate \$50,000 to a charity of your choice?

DENNY McCARTHY: Yeah, it's awesome. Anytime you can help out and give back, that's a bonus. I've had a really nice fall and I knew I was in the running this week and I was told on Thursday that I was in the hunt. Then I went out on Friday and made eight birdies, so I knew that was going to help towards this. Tough day out there today, but managed to scrape a few more birdies and here we are.

Q. Have you thought of any kind of charity that you would like to donate this to?

DENNY McCARTHY: Not yet. You know, talked about maybe possibly starting a foundation with this. Not sure about the charity yet, but looking forward to what this might go to.

Q. And what are your thoughts on the Birdies Fore Love program in the fall?

DENNY McCARTHY: Yeah, I think it's great. I think any time you can create this opportunity for us players to give back, I think it gives us some incentive to play and play well. I know Lanto, after he won, he could have probably taken an event or two off, but he really wanted to push forward and donate back. I think that's great. For myself as well, I think it's a great opportunity for something special going forward.

Q. You won the third most birdies in the fall. What does that say about your play to start off this year and this fall portion of the schedule?

DENNY McCARTHY: It means I'm playing great. I've been playing great for a while and making a lot of birdies. It just means I've gotten -- I've gotten to the level of game where I think it takes to compete out here. I feel like I've been getting better for a while and just kind of feel like I was knocking at the door a few times this fall to have a good chance to win. I had a good chance to win coming down the back stretch today if I maybe made a few more birdies. But it's definitely a really nice fall season.
