

**ROUND 3 INTERVIEW**

**BRETT QUIGLEY (-15)**

**Q. How's your experience so far in Morocco?**

**BRETT QUIGLEY:** Absolutely incredible. We went out a bunch. Great hotel, great people, great experience here at the club. Everybody treated us so well all week, and fortunately my golf is pretty good this week.

**Q. How do you feel about the win?**

**BRETT QUIGLEY:** It's been so long since I won a tournament, probably junior golf. Just incredible. It's weird, I had a peace all week, I was pretty comfortable all week. I wouldn't say I was nervous until the last hole here on my second putt, but just felt comfortable and just felt comfortable here in Marrakesh.

**Q. You were grinding all day. Was there a moment where you were like, oh, pedal down, I actually have a shot to win this?**

**BRETT QUIGLEY:** Got off to a good start. Then it's funny, I missed a short one on 8 for birdie and then I started thinking about score, thinking about the tournament, just kind of got a little bit in my own way. Somehow hit some good shots coming in and made some big putts, 13 and 14 were two huge putts.

**Q. Brett, is it easier to win when you are a rookie on the Tour?**

**BRETT QUIGLEY:** You know, I think it helped not having been playing too much the last few years. I had a lot of years off. I had a leg problem, I had three fractured vertebrae, so I've been home for almost seven years raising girls. I think a different perspective. I think I was happier to be here, more appreciative to be here in just a good mindset. I was maybe not trying as hard as I normally would, and sometimes in athletes or athletics or golf, when you try too hard, you grip too tight and you want it too much. This week I was much more relaxed.

**Q. You got really emotional just a bit ago. When you go through a journey like you did, 408 starts on the Tour, talked about your girls, is it sweeter when you get it?**

**BRETT QUIGLEY:** I'm going to say yes because they've never really seen me work. Like I said earlier, I do some work for Fox, USGA stuff, and great golf coverage, but they've never seen me play golf. So for them to see me play golf -- I'm going to get a little emotional here -- is neat.
