**Q. Josh Teater, 66-68. The 66 yesterday was the lowest round you ever shot here in Puerto Rico. Can you tell us what you found this week that you may not have found in previous years here?**

**JOSH TEATER:** I think a lot of times I get in this wind and I try to fight it, just kind of maybe get my ball position too far back, and I kind of made an adjustment to put it up a little bit and kind of let it help me instead of try to fight it. And on top of that, I think I'm rolling the ball well. I've had a lot of long putts, I think you saw some of those, but to get them in that range where the next one is not too much stress is always good.

**Q. Yeah, and I don't want to be negative, this is just your third cut of the year, it has been a struggle. How much pressure do you feel coming in the 20th event of the year, how much pressure do you feel, just your back against the wall and you're just going after it?**

**JOSH TEATER:** Yeah, I mean, I think the most -- I've been putting the pressure on me, on myself, and this week it was kind of different, it's just go play and let's have fun. We've been here before, we know what we're getting into, and enjoy it more and welcome it. Who knows what the rest of the year's going to hold, where I'm going to play, but I'm here this week.
