## DOC REDMAN (-7)

## Q. You were a prolific winner as a junior and an amateur. When was the most prolific time of your golfing career?

**DOC REDMAN:** Man, I don't know. I feel like I never -- you know, I won a lot, but not too much because I was always trying to kind of play up in junior golf. Once I committed to Clemson, I started playing the best amateur events I could play, whether that was in the state or across the country, just because I wanted to play against good college players. We played a great schedule at Clemson and I was playing the top amateur events. So playing guys like Scottie and Collin, and I was nowhere near as good as them back in the day. So I think I was all just building on good finishes, kind of like I have here, and wins when I could.

## Q. Scheffler, is that the Scottie?

**DOC REDMAN:** Yeah, Scheffler. Those guys, back when I was a freshman and they were juniors or seniors, however old they are, they were cream of the crop, and still are obviously. But I'm still getting a lot better and I think I still am, so I don't think I'm on necessarily the same timeline as those guys.

Q. And you're only -- how old are you now?

**DOC REDMAN:** Twenty-two. Yeah, it's crazy.

Q. That's pretty young. Do you feel young?

**DOC REDMAN:** You know, I guess in a lot of ways, yeah, and that's how I look at it. There's guys who play well in their mid 30s out here, so there's no rush for me to win or to kind of mature as a player. And I guess it helps, too, I feel kind of old because I've played a lot of events out here, you know, for a 22-year-old who this is their first year. So I've got a lot of experience and I feel very comfortable around the guys and around the courses, just navigating my way around the PGA TOUR.

Q. Could you talk a little bit about the positive memories coming back here and how different it was preparing for this week, that you knew you were in the field compared to last year?

**DOC REDMAN:** Yeah, I think it was a lot different. I was talking to some of my friends about it, I've come off two good finishes and a really good finish last year at this event, which has never really happened to me. So I've never had this kind of expectation externally or even internally if I let it, so just trying to make it the same as every other week. I think I feel very

comfortable because I've played well here and been here, so it just comes down to playing golf and doing the best I can.
