

CHASE SEIFFERT (-6)

Q. Chase, how would you assess this round today?

CHASE SEIFFERT: You know, it's a great round. Came here Monday, loved the golf course, and then it's nice to get off to a good start here.

Q. What did you love about the golf course so much when you got out here on Monday?

CHASE SEIFFERT: I just love kind of tree-lined, old-school golf courses, kind of tend to play them well. Good driver of the ball and it just kind of fit my eye, just one of those things.

Q. Since we've come back from the break, how do you feel your game has been?

Q. Chase, great start out there today, great iron play. This season, outside 100 approach to green, today currently sitting at No. 1. Was iron play a real strength for you?

CHASE SEIFFERT: It was. It's something I've really worked on during the break, to improve my wedges, improve my short irons. That's kind of where my weaknesses were and I put a lot of time in and it's really nice when it shows.

Q. A bit of an old, classic golf course. Overheard your last little chat there, you said you got here Monday, you instantly liked it. What caught your eye?

CHASE SEIFFERT: It's beautiful. It's tree lined, which I love. It kind of frames the holes for you. And then it's just tactical, you have to play smart, position your ball correctly.
