Q. J.J., quite a way to close your round. How would you kind of assess the final stretch there of your first round?

J.J. SPAUN: Yeah, I kind of got on a little roll there, it was nice. Birdied six out of the seven last holes, so it feels good to see putts go in and hit lots of fairways and lots of greens and just give myself chances.

Q. Did something change in your game those last like six, seven holes or maybe the putts just kind of started to fall?

J.J. SPAUN: Yeah, they started to fall. I gave myself a lot of opportunities on the back nine -- well, the front nine, which is the back. But just kind of, you know, hit one sloppy wedge and one sloppy 9-iron on 1 and 2, kind of just brought my focus in there and made a pretty stress-free easy birdie on 3. And then 4, I had a nice putt go in and it was just kind of like -- once I saw the putts go in, because I didn't really see any go in on my first nine, that kind of gave me the confidence to roll some nice putts in.
