So yeah, if I can get that nailed down, I'm pretty comfortable on the greens at the moment.

MATT WALLACE: Yeah.

Q. Do you feel that same way?

MATT WALLACE: Absolutely. I think I said then it was the best I was playing and I wasn't putting very well, and now you get the putter back and this game's all about putting. I kind of forgot it over time, but this game's all about putting. Yeah, got the putter going and able to shoot a score.

Q. Is it good just to kind of be able to focus on golf now after last week?

MATT WALLACE: Absolutely, yeah. I would say this round's for Radar. I just went out there and played. So with his comments of me just trying to shut up and go out and play, this one's for him.
