Q. A little bit disappointed with the round yesterday, Brian. How would you characterize today?

Q. What was kind of the key to your iron play today? You had some good shots there with your irons.

Q. A little bit disappointed with your putting yesterday. Did you feel a little bit better on the greens today?

BRIAN STUARD: Maybe a bit, but not much. I felt like I'm hitting some good putts, just not quite paying off yet, so maybe this weekend.

Q. Being a little disappointed with your first two days, still right there in contention, what do you feel like you need to really do over these next two days to stay in contention and possibly be able to win one?

BRIAN STUARD: Yeah, I think I need to keep driving it how I've been driving it, just tighten up my irons here and I think my putter's got to get hot, that's going to be the key for me.

Q. Is there something that's a little bit off, the speed, lines?

BRIAN STUARD: I think just kind of the combination, just not matching up. The greens, they've got some break to them, so you've got to really match up line and speed and just haven't been about able to do that quite yet.
