Q. After finishing second last year, what's your approach been like this time around to the course?

DOC REDMAN: I just try to make it like any other week, you know, not change anything. I think it's just nice coming here and having good vibes, good feelings from last year and just trying to recreate it, I guess. Every week's different and unfortunately it's tough to play two good years in a row, but I think this week so far has been good; not my best, but it's always fun coming out here. The course is fun, I think some other players have said it, it's fun to make birdies. It's not too easy out there, you've still got to play well.

Q. And what specifically did you learn about the course last year that you've tried to implement this year?

DOC REDMAN: Yeah, I mean, I think it's just classic golf, you've got to hit the fairway. And then the greens are back to front, they get kind of firm, especially when the weekend comes, so you've got to play to your spots. When you drive it well, I think there's tons of opportunities as people are seeing, but the rough's up a little this year, so you've got to hit the fairway.

Q. And just lastly, for tomorrow, what's your confidence level like that you can quickly rise up the leaderboard as you try to make as many birdies as you can?

DOC REDMAN: Yeah, I think a bunch of guys played early, I think it's nice for a weird reason, you know, guys play well early, the greens are a little smoother and you just go out and play. I think it got a little windy this afternoon, too. Nothing crazy. But yeah, I have all the confidence in the world that I can do it, it's just a matter of if it happens or not and I'm not going to press that.
