TYRRELL HATTON (-16)

Q. How would you sum up your week here in Detroit?

TYRRELL HATTON: Overall, pretty happy where I finished. I think I'm tied fourth at the moment, which is good. I imagine we'll probably slip down a few more with guys still out on the golf course and those birdie opportunities out there. It looks like it's another top-10, which obviously is nice, and a bit of time off now before we go again.

Q. Do you feel like your play coming out of the extended break there has been up to what you were hoping it would be?

TYRRELL HATTON: It's definitely exceeded my expectations. With the amount that I practiced leading into Hilton Head to have a chance to win was obviously surprising, but obviously enjoyed that feeling. And then maybe a little bit similar this week where I didn't really have high expectations, to be honest. My swing didn't feel good in practice and I said in Round 1 I didn't I feel too comfortable again, but we've grinded it out. I think the putter's done a great job for me this week. Yeah, you can't really complain with a couple of top-10s.

Q. How have you kind of set your schedule coming out of the break? How did you go about deciding where you were going to play?

TYRRELL HATTON: I kind of decided that I was going to take it easy and see how it all played out with obviously the testing and everything at the tournaments. Looks like I'm now probably going to have three weeks off until Memphis, so I'm definitely taking it very easy. Just at the end of the day you've got to do what's right for yourself and I think I'm comfortable with that and we'll just have to see how we go.

Q. Did the win at API kind of give you a little bit of buffer, a little bit of room there to say, "I can take it a little easier" maybe?

TYRRELL HATTON: A little bit. I mean, obviously like some guys aren't playing, they don't feel, I guess, too comfortable to come out. that's their decision, that's absolutely fine. I guess I'm not quite in that ballpark, but obviously with the schedule I've chosen, I'm not like fully committing to play every week. So I'm definitely taking it easy, but the fact I stayed out here in the States during the quarantine period has allowed me to kind of choose what events I want to play.
