

BRIAN HARMAN (-5)

Q. Talk about your round.

BRIAN HARMAN: Yeah, I've been battling my driver the last few weeks. I cracked one coming right off of the -- right out of the restart and I think I finally found a good one. I've been working hard on it, so it's nice to be able to play from the fairway.

Q. I was looking at your track record here and you're either feast or famine, you're either T-3, a 6th or a missed cut.

BRIAN HARMAN: Right.

Q. Can you explain that?

BRIAN HARMAN: Well, I think that when I'm playing well, I'm making a bunch of birdies here and if I'm a little bit off, it's hard to shoot low scores if you're playing out of the rough. So drove it well today. I'll try to keep driving it well.

Q. Sixty-nine from the FedExCup point standings coming in, that obviously would get you into BMW, but I don't know how much you look at the scoreboard the next couple of weeks, but always good to get those cushion points coming into a championship?

BRIAN HARMAN: Yeah, that's been my goal after the restart was make the TOUR Championship, so I'm just going to try to stay focused and play the best golf I can.

Q. What about the course conditions out here today? You guys didn't get any rain. It rained early in the morning. What did you think of the golf course setup?

BRIAN HARMAN: Man, they always do such a good job here. The greens are always a relief to come back and putt on Bermuda. That's what I grew up putting on. And the rough's thick and we're going to get some rain, but the course drains pretty good. It was nice and dry this morning. It's a really nice golf course to play, I really enjoy it.
