JERRY KELLY: I felt better today. Yesterday was rough, working with the guys in the trailer, and they really -- really got me unstuck. So, but I'm not going to the range, I'm going right to the trailer and see if I can stay unstuck all week. And then I can build off of that. But what I couldn't do what I did today yesterday, so it was nice.

Q. What do you think of this course?

JERRY KELLY: It's a treat. I feel really lucky we are able to play this golf course at this stage. It's a fantastic golf course. Bridgestone -- I played with the Bridgestone guys yesterday, and I was like, come on, sign for another five years out for this one, too. I love coming back here.

Q. Do you have some history here?

JERRY KELLY: Oh, yeah. Just playing plenty of times. I had my chances with good finishes, but Tiger won every time, so that's all there was to it.
