Q. Amazing round, tied for the lead here at Firestone. How was your break? You played at Ally as well, correct?

ROD PAMPLING: Yes.

Q. You did, yeah. So you are two weeks in. And how is everything going?

ROD PAMPLING: It's been good. Today wasn't the best ball-striking day, but I managed to scramble around really well, so that kept me in. And I made a couple nice birdies coming down the stretch.

Q. Did you -- so you weren't one of the guys that kind of put down the club for three months?

ROD PAMPLING: No. I have a 15-year-old who likes to play golf as well, so we -- that part was great, we got to play a lot of golf. So it kept me sharp. And we come out and ready to go.

Q. Can you take me back to kind of the first end of the pre-COVID with the season there, how your game was back then and kind of highlights from January, February, March.

ROD PAMPLING: It was solid. I came out the gates pretty well. I finished third at the Cologuard. I was playing with Bernhard on the last day and I was up there with a chance to win coming down the stretch, but didn't keep it going. But it was pretty good.

So I am just enjoying being out here. It's a lot more stress-free golf. You don't have to worry about smashing as far to keep up with the young guys. So that just makes the game a little bit more relaxing, which is good.

Q. Sure. Well, this being a major championship, is it kind of an event where you're going to go to the range after this, or you just kind of go home and --

ROD PAMPLING: No, I'll go a little bit on the range, just sort of work out -- try and work out what we were doing today. And yeah, it won't be a lot. Getting old. Recovery is not as good.

Q. Not as much of a grind.

ROD PAMPLING: Exactly. So it will be a little bit, but not too much.
