

**HARRIS ENGLISH ( -9)**

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**Q. Harris, what was the difference between the two nines today?**

**HARRIS ENGLISH:** Yeah, I couldn't really get it going on the back nine. Obviously it's got some harder holes in my mind. You've got 11, you've got 14, you've got 18, they're all really good long par 4s, really good par holes.

Got out of position on 14, got a little greedy with my bunker shot and you can't really get greedy with that pin, that's the hardest pin on the green. The greens are still really fast after all the rain we had yesterday. Pretty dumb double bogey, but I had a lot of birdie chances coming up. I didn't get No. 15, missed a short birdie putt there, but I knew on the front nine, started hitting fairways, get some wedges in my hand, send it close to the hole and I finally started matching the speed up on my putter and making some putts.

**Q. When you play well like you did yesterday and you have a 9 like that to start out today, when you make that turn, what were you kind of telling yourself? What was like your mental attitude when you made that turn?**

**HARRIS ENGLISH:** Yeah, just that I can get it. I mean, I knew pretty much every hole on the front nine's a birdie hole if you put yourself in the fairway and I knew I was going to have chances and to stay patient. I was 4 under for the tournament making the turn. Make a few birdies, get some momentum going and get it rolling and that's what I did.

**Q. Do you think, is there a reason you have like a comfort level kind of in this area of the country playing golf?**

**HARRIS ENGLISH:** Yeah, for sure. Close to home. It's more about the grass, I love playing bermudagrass. I feel like I can judge it really well. It's what I grew up on. I feel like I can read the greens, I don't have to overthink putts out here. I just really enjoy playing this golf course. This is my I think ninth-year playing up here and they just redid the greens my first year coming out here, so it's really all I know out here. I love this place and I like it when it plays firm and fast like it's hopefully going to with all this rain coming in.

**Q. You've had chances to win this year, you put yourself into contention again this week. What will you kind of draw on maybe from this year or even your past to kind of help guide you along these last 36 holes?**

**HARRIS ENGLISH:** Yeah, you can draw on a lot of good shots coming down the stretches of tournaments. I can harp on my finish last week at the PGA of finishing well there. That's really all golf is, is having some positive momentum and seeing those shots in your head

before you hit them. Had a lot of good stuff happen the past few weeks, so hopefully I can draw on that these next two days.
