**Q. Patrick, how would you assess your day?**

**PATRICK REED:** Rough. Just didn't really do anything that great. Hit it okay, missed a lot of putts, missed them high and low. Just kind of one of those days I'd burn edges rather than making putts. Besides that, I mean, everything else just seemed normal. It didn't seem anything spectacular, but at the same time that very easily could have been a 6, 7 under par round; instead, I only shot 2.

**Q. Was it speed or line more or less?**

**PATRICK REED:** Good question. There was no kind of consistency, it was either high or low, and every one of them was literally right over the edge. I mean, kind of how it was on the last hole of the day, kind of capitalized the day, horseshoed a birdie putt there and it just seemed that's how it was all day. Knee-jerking left and right, everything just kind of burning edges and because of that you're just not able to get a low round going.

**Q. What's your biggest focus for the next 36 holes?**

**PATRICK REED:** Make some putts. If I get the putter going, I'm hitting the ball plenty good enough to make a lot of birdies and to shoot really low. But doesn't matter how good you can hit it, you've got to make putts.
