

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

JORDAN SPIETH (-3)

Q. Jordan, how would you assess the day? Seemed like you had a big bounce back and then one foul ball there on 14.

JORDAN SPIETH: Yeah, I felt good. I was kind of trying to feel stuff out. I didn't feel great about the way I was swinging it early in the round and then I started to find a nice rhythm and hit a lot of really good shots. Felt like I hit some great putts this week that haven't gone in. Clearly the one on 14 off the tee will hurt, that's two strokes, but I feel like I'm playing like 8 under golf and I'm at 3., so I really hope that 3 holds. It's going to be close here on making the cut. I feel like with being able to play aggressive tomorrow, a little more fearlessly on the back nine, I had to watch it a little bit today after 14, I think that will help quite a bit for making a little run.

Q. Are you surprised at how compressed the leaderboard is?

JORDAN SPIETH: I don't think that's out of the ordinary here. Sometimes you get somebody up to 12 under or something through two rounds. But, I mean, there's a lot of wedges but you've got to be hitting fairways, and then really the defense of this golf course is where the pin locations are on the greens. There's so much slope, it's hard to make putts a lot of times. What that leads to is a lot of pars and a couple birdies. So no, I think it's bunched here, for sure.
