KENT JONES (-4)

Q. So you finished, I think it was a bogey-free 67; is that right?

KENT JONES: Yes, that's correct.

Q. What was going right out there for you today?

KENT JONES: I hit a lot of fairways, which, I mean, the fairways are wide. Then I think I hit every green, so I was never really in trouble, so that was nice. Hit it close a couple times and just really didn't make very many putts, but had lots of chances.

Q. You missed the first event; is that right? So this is your second one?

KENT JONES: That's correct, yep.

Q. How's the course suit you, would you say?

KENT JONES: I guess probably not -- doesn't probably suit me that great because it's wide fairways and I'm not one of the longer hitters but maybe straighter, so I would rather have it a bit tighter. But the course is in great shape. You know, the fairways are fantastic, ball's sitting up nice. Big greens, so I think you can hit a lot of greens, but have sort of a lot of lag putting. So I think just kind of getting a little better on the greens will help a lot next couple days.

Q. Did you play much during the break?

KENT JONES: I did, played quite a bit up until right before I came out. I was 17 days with no golf right before Firestone, so I was a little rusty starting off there. Then played good on the weekend, shot even par on the weekend there, so that was -- I saw some good signs coming into this week.
