

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

KEVIN SUTHERLAND (-8)

Q. Just thoughts on your round today.

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: You know, I hit it really well. I hit it really well the last two days actually and it was -- I made some putts coming in, which was nice. It's starting to warm up a little bit and maybe hopefully continue that into tomorrow.

Q. Freddie said, he said probably take about a 65 or a really low round. There's so many guys tomorrow that are there.

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: Totally agree. It's going to take something in the mid 60s, I think. It's just so packed together. There's guys that are in 15th place that are only like 2 or 3 back. It's going to take a really low one. Depends on how some guys finish this afternoon, too, you know. Some guys might be able to get to 10 or something like that, make a little bit of a separation, but it's going to take a low one either way.

Q. Do you like that mentality? You're the only player that shot 59 out here. Knowing that it's going to take a low one, do you like that?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: I kind of like it a little bit. I mean, in some ways it almost frees you up a little bit. You've got to go make birdies, there's no holding back, so you're aggressive from that standpoint.

But there's some holes out here though that you've got to be careful with. There's some tough holes. The 7th hole, 13 are both very difficult holes, so you've got to mind your Qs on those holes and get your par. And the 3rd hole, too, the same way. There's some holes you can make birdies on and you've got to be aggressive on those.
