ZACH JOHNSON (-16)

Q. Obviously great playing, but came down to one hole there. Just kind of walk us through that.

ZACH JOHNSON: Yeah, that hole's kind of bitten me both days. A 6 there yesterday and an 8 today and it's a par-5, which is very frustrating because those are the ones you usually try to take advantage of, especially today with, well, relatively speaking very benign conditions. Hit the worst shot of the week on the tee. I'm still at that point I'm trying to make a 5 instead of a 4, but got a little aggressive with my next shot, which is my third shot, and it just kind of snowballed from there. How do you make an 8? Well, I missed about a seven-footer for a 7, so I made an 8.

Q. In contention this week, obviously throughout the week, great playing. Just some thoughts on the week as a whole.

ZACH JOHNSON: We're going to draw a lot of positives. My game's really good. It's pretty darn consistent tee to green. The flat stick was for the most part pretty good. Gave myself a lot of good looks, even late I gave myself some good looks. Yeah, the state, the trajectory of my game is all on the positive side of the ledger, it's just a matter of executing a little bit better down the stretch. I mean, I hit the worst shot of the week today, but you can't do that. I'm going to focus on a lot of things I did well.
