

ROUND 3 INTERVIEW

KEVIN SUTHERLAND (-15, won 9th playoff hole)

Q. Kevin, you made a great putt in regulation to keep things going, another great putt here just a little while ago, but tell us about that second shot here at 17.

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: Yeah, you know, it was 163 if I remember right. One thing that helped is we realized how long that second shot was playing. When we came through here the first time, I think I had 141 and I can tell you all week long that's a pitching wedge as far as the ball's going. I hit a good 9-iron and it still wasn't enough. It was just a full 7-iron, felt like a good number, made a good swing. I was aiming a little left of the pin so it kind of cut in there nice for me. Underneath the hole, which was even better.

Q. This is your second win around here at Phoenix Country Club and the Charles Schwab Cup Championship. Why does your game fit so well around Phoenix Country Club?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: You know, if you had asked me that three years ago, I would have said because it feels comfortable the way I drive the ball here, and three years ago I drove the ball unbelievably well. This week wasn't quite like that. I didn't drive it quite as well yesterday and managed to hit some good drives here on 17 this week. You know, I don't know. I've always hit good iron shots here and I think it's a good eye for me.
