Q. Coming off a double at the 18th going to the 1st, how were you able to keep your composure and turn it around on that inward nine?

BRENDON TODD: Yeah, I really hadn't missed too many shots through 27 holes and the drive on 18 I think was just a little bit of water getting between the face and the ball because it started raining there when I was hitting that shot, so it squirted right and made double. Just got to put those in the past to get back to what you were doing well.

Q. How were you able to turn it around on that inward nine? You started making some putts, started hitting some greens.

BRENDON TODD: Yeah, I mean, I think the front for me sets up a little bit better as far as getting birdie looks and I did a good job of hitting a lot of greens, giving myself some chances and finally saw some putts go in.

Q. This is the third time you've defended now in your career. What did you learn from the first two experiences that you maybe apply to this week and this weekend?

BRENDON TODD: Putt well like you did when you won. That's really been the difference for me. The first two times I didn't putt very well in my defense and this week I'm starting to putt pretty good.
