**TONY FINAU (-11)**

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**TONY FINAU:** Didn't have it on the back nine for me. Luckily I'm still within reach. If I have a good round tomorrow, that's all a positive.

**Q. At what point (inaudible)?**

**TONY FINAU:** It wasn't a very good bogey on 11. I was in the middle of the fairway there. You're kind of licking your chops trying to attack that flag and make birdie and the worst you can walk away with there is par. Missed a short one for par.

And then it's crazy, this game does that to you sometimes. The momentum can either be in your favor, but it slowly got away from me there. Made another bogey on 12 and it was kind of an uphill battle.

**Q. We saw low scores today. We know what this course is capable of. What will be the mentality for the final round?**

**TONY FINAU:** Yeah, as you mentioned, a lot of guys scored today. Hopefully I'm one of those guys tomorrow that takes it low. It's going to take probably a low to mid 60s round for me tomorrow. Balls to the wall, try to make birdies, be one of those guys that are going low tomorrow.

**TONY FINAU:** I think you've got to get to 20 under. With enough guys around 11, 12, 13, 14 all the way up to 16 under, 20 under seems to be a good goal, probably what I'm going to be shooting for tomorrow.
