Q. Another great back nine out there. Kind of held serve on the front nine, made the mistake at 10, but then kicked in five birdies in the last six holes. Pretty impressive.

TOM HOGE: Yeah, you know, it was a bad swing off of 10 and kind of a tentative putt on 11 and I was a little hot after that, but I really tried to be determined to make good, confident swings and putting strokes the whole way in. Got a few going finally.
