TONY FINAU (-8)

Q. Tony, asked you on Sunday how long that was going to stay with you. How long did it stay with you?

TONY FINAU: Yeah, not very long. I was pretty enthusiastic, I had a nice finish last week after -- you know, I wasn't playing some great golf I feel like before, the couple weeks leading up, practice sessions and things, but I was (indecipherable) after last week and think it's showing this week.

Q. Can you walk us through the eagle on 7, please?

TONY FINAU: Yeah, on the seventh hole I hit a perfect 3-wood and wanted to keep it short of the bunker. I had about 80 yards to the hole. It was raining and windy and I just hit a perfect shot, a little knockdown sand wedge that one-hopped right in the hole so that was kind of a bonus, it was nice.

TONY FINAU: Yeah, I mean, I think wind, I seem to be a good wind player.

Q. Wins, as in victories.

TONY FINAU: Oh, wins as in victories? Oh, 100 percent. At the end of the day sports is about winning. I'm at that point in my career where it is about winning and every week I tee it up I challenge myself to put myself in contention to do that and I've done that nicely here with 36 holes to go.

Q. When you look back to last week, do you look at your play so much or the other player?

TONY FINAU: I always have to look at my play. There's some mistakes I for sure made on Sunday, but there's mistakes I made throughout the week so I can't single out Sunday as being the reason why. I wasn't able to play and finish a few shots better to win the golf tournament, but I was very encouraged after I left last week on some of the things I've been working on. It's been nice to put together 36 holes, a good 36 to start this week.
