Q. 2 under today on the South Course. Considering the conditions, how pleased are you with your round?

LANTO GRIFFIN: Very pleased. It was every type of weather, we had it today. Started out like kind of windy and chilly and then it got warm and then it started hailing and then stopped hailing and then started hailing. It was one of those days you kind of just have to embrace it. And I got a few good breaks out there to keep my round going. Yeah, I'm happy with it.

Q. You had an eagle on 6. Could you describe that for us?

LANTO GRIFFIN: Yeah. I hadn't been driving it well all day and I knew what I was doing wrong and I kept telling my caddie, I just can't do it, I know what I'm doing. I hit a really good tee shot, that felt good, kind of celebrated hitting the fairway. Then hit a 5-iron from 226 to about 20 feet and it was nice to see that one go in. That was a nice bonus.

Q. With such a bunched leaderboard going into the weekend, does that change your game plan for tomorrow?

LANTO GRIFFIN: This golf course is so difficult. The greens are going to be soft, but when it gets soft, that means it's going to play longer. Hitting fairways is going to be really important. This is one of the few golf courses really, you've just got to keep your head down and just play your game and see what happens. There's some crazy high scores and if you play well, get a few breaks, you can shoot 3 or 4 under par. That's going to be the goal on the weekend, just kind of keep the head down and see what happens.
