LANDON LYONS: When you're able to be hitting fairways and from the middle of the fairway, it makes the golf course a lot easier. The rough is juicy out there, so took advantage of that.

Q. How was the experience this week being out here at Torrey Pines on the APGA Tour playing a pro-am, hanging around the PGA TOUR guys? What has it been like?

LANDON LYONS: It's actually amazing. It's an opportunity of a lifetime on the APGA Tour, and what they're doing for the game is absolutely amazing and they're doing a great job continuing to build on that. Being able to play a golf course like this is breathtaking. It's one of those courses that you dream about playing day in and day out, comparing your game to PGA TOUR players and that's exactly what we were able to do this week.

Q. This is one of a lot of really good courses you guys are going to get to play this year, kind of a great run of courses. I imagine that's a key part of being out on this tour is where you get to go.

LANDON LYONS: Absolutely. What they're doing for the game is amazing, but them being able to get on a lot of PGA TOUR golf courses, TPCs is an opportunity that you can't really pass up on.

Q. You've been pretty outspoken about your support of diversifying the game and how the APGA Tour's doing that. What are some things you learned just kind of about that process with being out here with these guys out on this tour?

LANDON LYONS: Yeah, it's a great group of guys. I mean, I'd rather play on this tour than any other tour. I don't know what it is, I'm able to get along and click with the guys a lot, so it's nice to have that. Top to bottom, it's what they're doing for the game is amazing and the golf courses they're able to play, kind of stack your game up against PGA TOUR players.

Q. What are some of the obstacles have these guys shared with you that they've faced or that you've faced that this tour is going to help?

LANDON LYONS: Yeah, it's just getting out there. For a lot of these guys, just having the opportunity and that's what they're doing, giving the opportunity to play great courses and great competition and kind of get the word out there to everybody to kind of diversify the game a little bit is great.

Q. How important is it to have sponsors like Farmers Insurance supporting the APGA

LANDON LYONS: Yeah, it's very important to have sponsors like the Farmers Insurance, a lot of the great sponsors that they have. It helps them be able to have these big purses and play these great golf courses. It's very important in the game.

I think he'll bounce back stronger after that, getting a couple more sponsor invites and really help his game out. I think he's on the right track.
