

TOMMY GAINEY

Q. Well, Tommy, incredible round. Birdied half your holes today. Just some comments on the round in general?

TOMMY GAINEY: Well, I hit it really good today. I hit really two bad shots. I hit a bad shot on the par 3, No. 6, and ended up making bogey. And I hit another bad shot on the back nine. But it's windy, it's Puerto Rico. I'm just glad that it's 80 degrees outside, because back in South Carolina, all it is, is 40 degrees and raining. So I'm just glad to be in some hot weather. Wind, I can deal with. But I just hit it really good today. I had one three-putt, which I hit it 12 feet on No. 11 and then three-whacked it. So I'm not happy about that, but really happy at bouncing back with a birdie on 12. Just showing a little resilience and confidence to come back from a bogey, because when you three-putt from 12 feet, come on, let's be honest, that's bad.

Q. Just assess the state of your game coming into the week. Have you been feeling confident, feeling like a round like this coming on?

TOMMY GAINEY: Well, you know, I played last week in Sarasota, at Lakewood National Golf Club, I think -- I believe it is. I shot 6 under the first round. I hit it really good last week. Hit a few bad drives the last couple days, wasn't able to get anything out of the game. But I have been hitting good for a while. And today I just made more putts than I've made in a while. And, let's be honest, I mean, when you get your putter rolling out here, you can take it deep. And with me hitting the ball the way I am off the tee to green, the hot putter is -- that's why I shot 65 out there today.

Q. You have had a less-than-ideal track record here at the Puerto Rico Open. Are you able to just wipe that out, wipe past missed cuts, whatever the case may be, and just come here, start fresh, and do exactly what you did today?

TOMMY GAINEY: Well, you know, I get it, my track record is not very good here in Puerto Rico at this place. But you know what? Sooner or later, it's got to change. I mean, I'm hitting it good, putting it good. The whole game's in good shape right now. So it's time to make a change. It's time to win one. It's time to win this tournament. I'm hitting it good enough to win, and it's just time for me to get back out on the PGA Tour, where I belong.
