

**JHONATTAN VEGAS**

**Q. Wonderful, Johnny. A second consecutive 4 under 68, birdied the last two holes today, makes it taste a little better. Just a few comments on today's round.**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** I mean, this is some day. From the beginning all the way to the end, right in the middle of the round, I just quite didn't hit my irons well enough. But I just feel like I have been driving the ball well, especially under these windy conditions and a firm golf course. Hitting from the fairway makes a big difference here. I have been able to do that for two days. So hopefully going to continue to do that.

**Q. What did you think was the biggest standout hole or shot that really gave you some confidence today?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Well, I mean, pretty much since the beginning. I hit a bunker shot on the second hole from like 230 yards out of a fairway bunker and hit it about 50 feet for eagle. Didn't make the putt, but once I hit that shot, I knew that the confidence was there and the ball striking was there to have a good round.

**Q. What did you hit out of there?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** I hit a 5-iron, 5-iron, choked down 5-iron. And like I said, it was a nice shot today.

**Q. Okay. And just some thoughts on your comments coming into the week? Have you been feeling pretty good about this?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Well, it hasn't been particularly great for the past -- from the beginning of the season. Obviously the year didn't start for me, testing positive for COVID, stuff that you can't control. And then obviously you get into the week of San Diego, not feeling 100 percent, not being prepared 100 percent, which it was tough to kind of play there. And had a decent week at Pebble, but it's still not great. So obviously the year is kind of getting started for me and I'm just feeling confident, feel like I have been doing the right things, and I'm just waiting for the game to show up.

**Q. Can we just do one for Spanish?**
