

SEAMUS POWER

Q. Good round today, 67. Just a few thoughts on how it all came together.

SEAMUS POWER: Yeah, I played nicely. The wind has kind of died now a little. But when we were in the middle of the round, the wind was really blowing. So pretty pleased. I didn't play the par 5s as well as I would have liked, but overall kind of had a nice round, and hopefully another good one for tomorrow.

Q. How much did that brief rain shower -- did that -- were you (inaudible) stop down for a bit, or --

SEAMUS POWER: We got three on the course. We got one early on the fourth. It rained for maybe two minutes, the wind didn't die. We got one on 15, the wind didn't die. And then it started to kind of mist now when the wind died. So it's kind of, yeah, changing conditions. But I guess, I mean, growing up in Ireland, you get used to kind of changing conditions. But it's interesting. I mean, even in 30 minutes there, you go from having 25-mile-an-hour wind help on 16 and to 18 almost no help. So it's -- you kind of are adjusting as you go. But overall it definitely makes some little effect there, yeah.

Q. Is there a shot or two or a hole that you're particularly proud of that was kind of a momentum for you?

SEAMUS POWER: I birdied 14 today, which is nice. I bogeyed that the first two days. Hit a different club off the tee, kind of different start, and it worked, made a birdie. So, I mean, that's always kind of nice when you see something pay off. But, I mean, overall, I like the course. Always kind of felt pretty comfortable here. So it's just more about hitting some good shots.

Q. What did you hit off the tee this time?

SEAMUS POWER: A 3-wood.

Q. 3-wood this time?

SEAMUS POWER: Yeah.
