Q. How tough were those conditions out there?

ABRAHAM ANCER: A lot more water, the rough is high. Over there you can definitely miss in some spots and work with the slopes, and here it's way, way harder to do that, to play with wind out here. It's very -- almost no room for error, to be honest.

Q. And it's a long way away, I realize, but you did have an International Presidents Cup team dinner earlier this week. Just how encouraged are you to play that well on this course that will have that tournament next year?

ABRAHAM ANCER: Definitely. It was nice to see the guys and have dinner with them and with Coach or Captain Trevor. I know it's more than a year and a half from now, but we've still got to get ready and get some reps in here. It's always important, it's a big golf course and it's good to practice as much as you can. Yeah, I'm pumped I played well. All the golf courses that you have to just grind it out and it's not easy and this is definitely one of those.
