

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

ALEX CEJKA (-7)

Q. Okay. Alex, this is your third Champions start play. You have just had a great day, 3 under. Your thoughts on the round?

ALEX CEJKA: It's actually a little bit tricky, yesterday and today with the wind. It's really in the trees. But it's a great golf course. The greens are super fast. A lot of grain on those downhill, down grain. It's really fast. So you got to be careful. And so far I have been playing great. Not really many mistakes so far. And I'm glad to be in this position.

Q. Did you play here at all -- you had a couple days off before coming here.

ALEX CEJKA: No, this is the first time. I played I think Tuesday, Wednesday, and for the first time. Great impression, great golf course. Suits my eyes. It's a good ball-striking course. And just the wind makes it a little bit tricky.

Q. Yeah, what in particular do you like about this golf course?

ALEX CEJKA: Sometimes you come to a golf course and it just suits your eyes. Everybody likes different golf courses. I like that it's like treeline golf, old-style golf courses, and you got to shape the balls. And I have been doing it so far.

Q. How pleased are you with how you have started on PGA Tour Champions? I know you have played yourself into next week. You're in this week.

ALEX CEJKA: Yes, I'm pleased. I'm just grateful for every start I get. I know it's tough. There's only 80 guys every week in the field. So many old great players who aren't -- they are privileged out here to play. And I got to prove myself. And if it takes -- if I have to go back to Monday qualifier or do a top-10 to get me in next week, I will do whatever is necessary to do.

Q. How excited are you for this weekend? It's a major championship this week.

ALEX CEJKA: Yes. For me, I got to take it like a normal tournament. I don't want to put extra pressure on it, nor big expectations. Just play my golf, my game, and maybe get lucky. And with a couple up-and-downs and just see what happens in the next 36 holes.

Q. Do you have your dogs with you this week?

ALEX CEJKA: No, I'm riding solo. So I'm disappointing and just Skyping and -- but it's nice to be on your own for a week or so.
