LUKE LIST (-6)



Q. Is there a fundamental difference between yesterday and today? It seemed like the wind was the same, but it seemed like the scoring was a little harder.

LUKE LIST: I haven't looked at all the scores. It looks like there were some good ones kind of --

Q. Early?

LUKE LIST: Yeah, oddly, early. And then I mean, what's Keith, 4, 5 under on the day? 5, yeah. So that's a heck of a round today. I thought the pin placements were just as tough if not tougher today. I think that if you got used to the wind yesterday, that might have been a little bit of the difference today, a little easier. But it's playing challenging out there, you've got to hit it well. Like even the putts, the grain changes are pretty challenging. It's set up really fair, but difficult.

Q. Is it because this golf course is so difficult, is it safe to say that almost any lead is probably not safe?

LUKE LIST: Yeah, I would say that. Yeah, someone could go out at 1 or 2 -- if Keith finishes at 9 under or 10 under, whatever he is, someone could go out and shoot a good number in the morning with no wind and shoot 7 or 8 and post and everybody could struggle in the afternoon. I would say it's really bunched up from what it looked like to me on the leaderboard, so anybody's still in it within six or seven shots.

Q. Luke, how often do you think about winning that first PGA TOUR title?

LUKE LIST: Yeah, think about it all the time. I've got a few more pressing issues that are more at the forefront for me, like trying to get the ball in the hole and trying to not think too much on the putting green. It's just the winning stuff, I think about that more when I'm not playing, but I guess when I'm out there, I've got a few other things that I'm thinking about.
