Q. Gary, just an overall assessment of the day.

GARY WOODLAND: Yeah, a little frustrating. I was happy with the way I played, I gave myself a lot of chances, just didn't score. But I drove the ball beautifully again. Iron play's continuing to get better, puttering, short game, everything's pretty good. So excited about my game. Q. What are maybe the main things you're going to work on with them? Is it just kind of fine tuning?

GARY WOODLAND: Yeah, just fine tuning, continuing to do what I'm doing. just continue to get more confident, continue to work hitting different shots. Right now I was pretty much just playing left to right all week, but we'll continue to work on the other stuff and we'll be ready to go at the PGA.

Q. Did you play Kiawah?

GARY WOODLAND: I did. I enjoyed it. The golf course obviously suits me very well, big-boy golf course. So that I'm excited about and coming in with a lot more confidence and a lot better game.
