ERNIE ELS: Yeah, I've got to check the map. After Ohio, I went down to Texas for a day and then flew up here kind of in the middle of the night, so I'm still getting my bearings. Yeah, I've never been up here. I've been up to where we play the U.S. Open and PGA.

Q. Rochester?

ERNIE ELS: Rochester. That's New York. Rochester, New York, near Buffalo, but never been up here, so you're never too old to learn.

Q. What have you heard from your fellow players about this event? It's usually a favorite.

ERNIE ELS: Yeah, I saw Joey Sindelar's been a real great ambassador to the event. He spoke to me even last year, what a great place this is and how proud he is of the whole area and how much Dick's does for the area and the tournament. Yeah, the guys are very excited

about this event. I think it's the 50th year anniversary or something like that for the tournament, so it's been hosted here for many, many years. People in the community know the tournament and it seems like it's an event where people really get together and enjoy not only the golf but also the social part of the event.
