ROUND 1 INTERVIEW JULY 1, 2021

Just not getting much out of it, just kind of playing okay but just not quite good enough. I don't know, I thought last week was a little better. Maybe could have built on that a little bit, but today just kind of, I don't know, a little disappointing today.

Q. And just what's it like -- you were fan favorite two years ago and you went T-5. What's the contingent like out here? Got the Golden Grizzly on your bag, I'm sure, still. What's it like to have the fans out here supporting you locally?

BRIAN STUARD: Yeah, it's great. A lot of friend and family today, which was nice. It's cool to, like you said, have the fans back. Last year it was kind of, you know, one of those things. It's exciting to be back and playing in front of some fans.

Q. I know your first shot today you dedicated, it was a dedication. Why was that important for you to do? I don't know how well you knew Tim, but why was that important for you to do today?
