

**ROUND 2 INTERVIEW**  
**July 3, 2021**

**GIBBY GILBERT III (-4)**



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**Q. Gibby, that was a hot start there, 31 on the front. Just take us through your round today.**

**GIBBY GILBERT III:** Yeah, I got off to a hot start, was hitting the ball really well, made some good putts. Then back side I just, I don't know, I don't know if it was the weather, just rain and -- you know, I don't know, I just lost it, but I'll take it.

**Q. Speaking of the weather, it was off and on. How did you keep your mind focused, especially on that back nine?**

**GIBBY GILBERT III:** I didn't, I didn't do a good job. I shot 2 over on the back. It's tough, it's tough to do that and I didn't do a good job. Just seemed like there was a couple critical holes on the back side, tough holes that seemed like every time we got to one of those holes it was raining, so made a couple bogeys coming in. Hope I play well tomorrow.

**Q. Weather aside, tomorrow's sort of looking like a better day. What's the preparation look like for the final round?**

**GIBBY GILBERT III:** Yeah, I think you're just going to have to go low. The course is in really good shape, the greens are fantastic, so I think you have to shoot something really low.

**Q. You were even par yesterday. To come up and now be under 4, did you wake up on the right side of the bed or what was it?**

**GIBBY GILBERT III:** I've had an injury the past six weeks, so I wasn't even for sure if I was going to get to play here. I got in the field late on Friday and didn't even know, had to go out and hit some balls, I hadn't hit any balls in six weeks, so wasn't even sure I was going to be able to play. I think I just found a little rhythm out there today. It was good yesterday towards the end, so I just kept it going.
