**Q. Opening round 7 under coming into the clubhouse, was almost kind of tied for the lead at 8 under. Tell me about your round.**

**JOSEPH BRAMLETT:** Solid day, yeah. Played well, scored well, made some putts. All in all, just played well all day.

**Q. And highlighted by two eagles. Tell me about those.**

**JOSEPH BRAMLETT:** Yeah, I mean, I've gotten a little bit more speed this year, which has helped, so the par 5s are a little bit more shorter for me. I had an 8-iron in on one, 7-iron in on the other and I hit some really good iron shots, so gave myself good looks and knocked them in.

**Q. From the scorecards, looks like it's going to take like a birdie-fest to really make it through, but what do you need going into these next three rounds?**

**JOSEPH BRAMLETT:** Just got to keep going. I mean, we're one round in and we're going to have to get way under par to win this tournament. The greens are in good shape, they're pretty soft, the course is receptive, so these guys are good, the scores are going to get low.

**Q. Do these softer greens play more towards your game, or the style of the course?**

**JOSEPH BRAMLETT:** I don't know that that matters so much. I just feel like my game is in pretty good shape, so if I play well, I can do good things.
