TAYLOR PENDRITH (-7)

Q. Back in the clubhouse, tell me about how this opening round went. Takeaways from today?

TAYLOR PENDRITH: Yeah, it was good. Got off to a really nice start, made an eagle on 5, I think, and hit the driver really nice today. I think I only missed two fairways and I think it was 17 and 18. Drove it really nicely. Had some good wedges into the greens and was able to make some putts.

Q. What will it take going into future days, because there's definitely a lot of holes birdie and you've even had an eagle, so low scores.

TAYLOR PENDRITH: Yeah, totally. Just got to hope for more of the same this week. It's super soft out there, so definitely ideal scoring conditions today. If I can get the ball in the fairways and hit some more good wedges, then hopefully have a few more good rounds.

Q. Does having the course softer play more towards your game, or course setup like this?

TAYLOR PENDRITH: I think so, yeah. I hit a lot of drivers today, which is my strength, because the ball's not really bouncing. Can kind of take some more aggressive lines off the tees. Drove it amazing. Had, I think, wedge into most of the par 4s, so hit a lot of greens and made some putts.
