

**ROUND 2 INTERVIEW**  
**July 16, 2021**



**LUKE LIST (-11)**

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**Q. Luke, 4-under par 68, nice round. If we can get some comments, please.**

**LUKE LIST:** Yeah, I knew with the delays yesterday, like short rest, so I didn't feel quite as comfortable today. I was happy to go bogey-free. I didn't have it on the greens, but I struck it around pretty nicely and I'm ready to get some rest.

**Q. How were the conditions this morning compared to yesterday?**

**LUKE LIST:** Really good. Pins were a little tougher, but it's soft and it's gettable, so I imagine I'll probably about 3 or 4 back going into the weekend. That's fine. Like I said, didn't quite have it, focus on the greens, but I knew I'm putting well so I'm looking forward to getting some rest for the weekend.

**Q. Took advantage of the par 5s today, birdied three of the four.**

**LUKE LIST:** Yeah, a couple easy two-putts and had a good eagle putt on 5. Yeah, I'm rolling it nice, just didn't really have, like I said, the lines today and you've got to have perfect speed and line out there. But it's gettable. The wind's up a little bit more than yesterday, but it's still soft, you can attack.

**Q. You led after 36 last week. Talk a little bit about that experience and how the weekend played out for you last week and what you'll take into this weekend.**

**LUKE LIST:** Yeah, there's a lot of golf left. I know like last week and this week, you've got to make a lot of birdies and I'm expecting to have to keep the pedal down and just continue to hit fairways and greens and make a lot of putts. That's kind of the mentality you have to have. You can't just play for pars out there.

**Q. What did you think of your round?**

**LUKE LIST:** Yeah, it was okay. Anytime you go bogey-free, you've got to be happy with that. I left some out there, but like I said, I knew it was going to be kind of a battle just with the short turnaround from yesterday. I was a little fatigued, I felt like, some focus wasn't as good, but I was proud of the way I went bogey-free, hung in there, didn't really put too much stress on myself.

**Q. What do you think -- I know everybody's saying 20-some under is what you need.**

**LUKE LIST:** Yeah, it just depends. If it gets more thunderstorms, more rain and the course

continues to stay soft, which I think it will, yeah, you've got to make birdies and attack. I'm sure something in the 20s will be the score.

**Q. I meant to ask you yesterday, how does a guy from Seattle end up at Vanderbilt.**

**LUKE LIST:** I was born in Seattle, but I grew up in Georgia. I moved when I was 6 years old to the south. I wouldn't consider myself really anything other than from the south. Yeah, I grew up mostly in Georgia, that's why I went to Vanderbilt.
