

ROUND 3 INTERVIEW

JIM HERMAN (-14)

Q. Third round in, one more to go, looks like things were really picking up on that back nine carding six birdies.

JIM HERMAN: Yeah, pretty slow, just a regular round of golf. I made a terrible, terrible bogey on 11 and caddie just gave me a little pep talk and tried to birdie in and we were close. But yeah, I made some birdies. You need to. James put up a low number today and that's awesome, 60. We're all shooting for him tomorrow.

Q. Did you catch wind of that when you were out on the course that he was chasing 59?

JIM HERMAN: We never knew exactly what it was, but we knew it was pretty low. I think that was right around when I started making a few birdies. You see that and you're like you've just got to go. You shoot 2 or 3, you might keep your place in the field, so you have to get something going.

Q. No stranger to this course, you can see that 59's almost doable. You've been in this position before. What does it take for tomorrow?

JIM HERMAN: Well, obviously Sundays are different. Saturday's moving day. Two years ago Kelly had a 61, I had a 62, James put up a 60 today, so we tighten up a little bit on Sundays, but for us chasing him, we've got to go low. I have a little experience with that, 63 at Wyndham last summer on a Sunday to win, so going to draw on some of that and just go as low as we can.
