LUKE LIST (-18)

Q. Bogey-free round. What was clicking today?

LUKE LIST: Yeah, I mean, I had to stay really patient. I forget which leaderboard I saw where James shot 60 and, you know, I think I was like 6 or 7 down after four holes. I missed a short one on 4, and I knew the par 5s, if I hit good drives, I could attack those and fortunately I did again and threw a few other ones in there. That's why there's 18 holes, you've got to kind of hang in there and fortunately I was able to do that today. I was a little frustrated early because I was, like I said 6 or 7 back, but hung in there and had a good back nine.

Q. Probably early on in your round you saw he was chasing 59, so what does that show about the course that 60 --

LUKE LIST: Yeah, it's a heck of a round. I didn't see if he had a birdie putt on the last or anything, but 60, 12 under's an unbelievable round on any golf course, much less on Tour. It is gettable, the greens are soft, but to be able to make that many putts is really impressive.

Q. It's been clicking for you, but what will it take going into tomorrow's round?

LUKE LIST: Yeah, I mean, I'm going to lean on my ball-striking, I've been striking it really well the last few days, and if I can hole a few putts, I'll be right there.

Q. Is that confidence coming into your game? You're coming off some top finishes of the season, kind of been around the leaderboard.

LUKE LIST: Yeah, last week was a top-5 so that was obviously good to be there and I can lean on that a little bit, what to do, what not to do. If I feel like if my game's in a good spot, my head's in a good spot, that usually leads to some good finishes.
